In 2025, BIOKET will proudly introduce the **Innovation Awards**, a new initiative to recognize and celebrate cutting-edge technologies, processes, and products that are shaping the future of bioeconomy. This award provides a unique opportunity for innovators to gain visibility, showcase their solutions to a global audience, and further promote the adoption of sustainable practices.

By submitting your innovation, you agree to make yourself available during the conference from March 11 to 13, 2025 in Brussels, Belgium.

1. Eligibility Criteria

- All applicants must be registered at BIOKET 2025.
- Innovations introduced recently or expected to be introduced to the market are eligible.

2. Submission Guidelines

After registering, applicants must submit the following materials:

- The application must be submitted via this link: <https://bioket.tech/innovation-awards-sign-up-form/> by February 7th, 2025 in PDF format.
- A leaflet or additional information in PDF format about the innovation in English.
- The application should not exceed two pages, structured as follows:
 - Page 1: Company and product identification details.
 - Page 2: Description of the innovation and its competitive advantage.
- Printable digital images (300 dpi) of the product that can be used free of charge in media advertising.
- Details on what makes the innovation special, when it was or will be introduced to the market, and how it aligns with sustainability standards (such as SDGs, certifications, labelling, etc.).
- Company logo, a short bio (max 150 characters including spaces), and social media links and website.
- Optionally, a short video (optional but encouraged) showcasing the innovation.
- Incomplete applications or those not adhering to the guidelines will not be considered.
- Files larger than 10MB should be sent via a download platform link.

3. Jury & Evaluation Process

- A jury composed of academic experts from the BIOKET scientific committee will review all applications.
- Entries will be evaluated based on innovation, market introduction potential, and sustainability.
- The president of the jury will announce the winner during the plenary session on Thursday, March 13, 2025.

4. Participation Requirements

- All applicants must attend BIOKET 2025 and be available for its full duration, from 11 to 13 March, 2025 in Brussels, Belgium.
- Any selected winner who is absent during the symposium will forfeit the award.

5. Conference Registration

- **Fees:** Applicants must register for the conference and pay the applicable fees.
- **Discounts:** Check for any additional discounts or special rates at bioket.tech

6. Authorization

- By submitting an application, you agree to provide BIOKET permission to use submitted materials (images, descriptions) for promotional purposes.
